Guest Speakers

Ross Perry of SRPEDD discussed the possibility of technical assistance for e-Government and said he was open to assist with possible funding opportunities. E-Government was defined as using Internet access to municipal forms and documents, downloading permits, paying tax bills online, electronic posting of schedules, agendas, events, etc. Also the possibility of Reverse 911 and social media.

SRPEDD's role could be in project management, bringing municipal reps together to develop RFP's if necessary, to conduct evaluations and negotiate with a selected vendor.

Michael Coughlin, from the DPH Commissioner's office briefly addressed the Coalition on the topic of exploring regional collaborative opportunities. He will be sending out a copy of the slide presentations via MAHB.

Executive Committee Report – Janice McCarthy stated that the Board would receive Equipment requests until a deadline of March 15th. The requests for data lines will be factored into the available funds for communications. Marcia Benes asked if there was interest in obtaining emergency cots, as Jeanne Spalding has offered to put together a bulk purchase order. Marcia Benes will be creating a spreadsheet based on responses received by March 15th, for the Executive Board to be able to decide on how to spend down the remaining funds at their April meeting.

Sandy Landry and Jeanne Benincasa gave brief updates on their planning and MRC related activities.

The statewide advisory committee meeting was postponed, so there was no LSAC report from representative Lisa Cullity
